The tasks include scientific services. The primary area of responsibility includes the organic synthesis compounds and peptides.

It is a temporary training position that can be beneficial for further professional careers. The time limit is appropriate to the training objective. The time limit is based on Section 2 (1) WissZeitVG. The general terms and conditions of employment and the personal requirements for employment as a research assistant are based on Section III.3 of the Philipps University Mar-burg's fixed-term guidelines for the fixed-term employment of academic staff (fixed-term guidelines).

A completed scientific university degree (diploma, master's or comparable) in chemistry is required. Practical experience in organic chemistry and / or peptide synthesis is required. In addition, the applicant must be able to work independently with organic synthesis. Basic knowledge of chemical biology and biochemistry (protein expression) is desirable. The person to be recruited should also be interested in learning biological methods (e.g. cell culture).
